 Vaccine Policy	Vaccine required for 12+ years old  All crew and guests who are eligible to be vaccinated must be fully vaccinated with all initial doses administered at least 14 days prior to sailing. We highly recommend guests ages 5 to 11 are also vaccinated. COVID-19 Booster Vaccine shots are not currently required to sail on Celebrity Cruises.	All crew and guests who are eligible to be vaccinated must be fully vaccinated with all initial doses administered at least 14 days prior to sailing. Effective April 15, 2022, this will include all guests 5 years of age and older on sailings departing the US. Only vaccines that are fully approved or authorized for emergency use by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) or the World Health Organization (WHO) will be accepted.  Guests with a mixed series of any two of the following vaccines taken within a minimum of 28 days between doses, will also be considered fully vaccinated: Pfizer, Moderna, Johnson & Johnson, AstraZeneca, Sinovac, Sinopharm, or Covaxin. Youths who have received one dose of a vaccine (other than Johnson & Johnson) will not be considered fully vaccinated.  To comply with this requirement, documentation of full vaccination must be provided at the terminal as a condition for boarding. Celebrity Cruise will not accept any form of Certificate of Recovery.  COVID-19 Booster Vaccine shots are not currently required to sail on Celebrity Cruises.
 Homeport Country Requirements	<b>Ecuador - As of February 11, 2022</b> -All travelers 3 years and older must show proof of vaccination (with QR code or physical document) with all Covid-19 vaccine doses administered at least 14 days prior to entry OR a negative RT-PCR test administered no more than 72 hours prior to the flight to Ecuador. -Children under 3 years old are not required to present a vaccination card nor a RT-PCT test. -Any traveler who during the flight or upon arrival in Ecuador presents symptoms related to Covid-19, regardless of their vaccination status or negative RT-PCR test, will be evaluated by the Public Health authorities prior to entering the Migration area. If the traveler is considered a suspect case, an antigen test will be taken and if the result is positive, the traveler must undergo a 10-day quarantine. -Name on test results and vaccination card must match government issued identification  A Traveler's Health Declaration Form needs to be presented to airline at time of boarding. <b>Form can be found here:</b> <a href="https://bit.ly/3hCVD7">https://bit.ly/3hCVD7</a>  <b>Galapagos - As of February 11, 2022</b> -All travelers 3 years and older must show proof of vaccination (with QR code or physical document) with all Covid-19 vaccine doses administered at least 14 days prior to entry OR a negative RT-PCR test administered no more than 72 hours prior to the flight to Ecuador. -Children under 3 years old are not required to present a vaccination card nor a RT-PCT test. -Name on test results and vaccination card must match government issued identification.  Travel Insurance with medical and evacuation coverage is a government requirement.	All Travelers:  Effective, December 6, 2021, all air passengers, regardless of vaccination status, must present a negative COVID-19 test taken no more than one (1) day before travel to the United States.
 Celebrity Cruises Boarding Requirements	For sailings through March 31, 2022, all vaccinated guests are required to present a negative COVID-19 test result at the time of embarkation. This test may be taken as either as an Antigen or PCR test, conducted within two days of boarding the ship. Package guests will receive a complimentary COVID-19 test in Quito prior to the exclusive flight. Non-package guests will receive a complimentary COVID-19 test and a health check in Balta prior to embarkation.  Unvaccinated children between the ages of two and eleven years old will be required to bring a negative PCR test conducted within three days of boarding. These guests will have an additional COVID-19 test at the terminal prior to embarkation and on the day before disembarkation.  For sailings starting on March 5, 2022 and forward, guests who have been diagnosed with Covid-19 within the last 90 days and have completed at least 10 days of isolation prior to boarding, are exempt from testing as long as they have a Certificate of Recovery and are asymptomatic. The Certificate of Recovery must be shown to the medical team upon arrival in Quito (package) or Balta (non-package). Guests will be asked to wear a mask and practice social distancing while inside. Guests who do not have a Certificate of Recovery from a doctor and are symptomatic, will need to be tested. This test may be taken as either as an Antigen or PCR test, conducted within two days of boarding the ship. Each guest is responsible for making their own arrangements with an accredited testing provider as well as covering all associated costs.  Unvaccinated children between the ages of two and eleven years old will be required to bring a negative PCR test conducted within three days of boarding. These guests will be provided an additional COVID-19 Antigen test at the terminal prior to embarkation and on the day before disembarkation. The CDC has advised unvaccinated guests cannot be tested twice in one day as it may affect the accuracy of the test results, therefore the COVID-19 test required before arriving at the terminal cannot be taken on boarding day. A registration link for required onsite testing at the terminal will be emailed separately.  Beginning with sailings departing on or after March 18, 2022, guests who have recently recovered from COVID-19 may present a Certificate of Recovery and proof of the positive PCR test result taken between 11-90 days prior to the sail date in order to board. We will not accept a Certificate of Recovery in place of a vaccination record. Additionally, please be aware that some ports of call do not accept a Certificate of Recovery for the purposes of debarking and enjoying the destination.  Face Masks	*Masks are mandatory during the pre & post-cruise stay in Quito -Effective February 25, 2022, face masks will be optional on board for all vaccinated guests. Masks will continue to be required for unvaccinated guests, at all times indoors, except while eating or drinking. This policy will be re-evaluated on a continuous basis. -Masks are not required while visiting uninhabited islands. Masks are required while visiting populated islands.	Effective February 25, 2022, face masks will be optional on board for all vaccinated guests. Masks will continue to be required for unvaccinated guests, at all times indoors, except while eating or drinking. This policy will be re-evaluated on a continuous basis.  Masks are not required in ports of call unless required by local governments.
 While Ashore	Shore Excursions are included in the Galapagos Itineraries.	All <b>vaccinated</b> guests may go ashore on their own in ports where it's permitted. Families touring with <b>unvaccinated</b> children may only go ashore if participating in an excursion provided by Celebrity Cruises.  In some ports (i.e. Nassau) a vaccination card may be required to enter select venues and restaurants.  Excursions provided by Celebrity Cruises are required in: Bridgetown, Barbados; Castries, St. Lucia; Kingstown, St. Vincent; Roseau, Dominica.  In St. Lucia, Barbados, and Dominica, fully vaccinated guests may also choose to visit the enclosed port area to enjoy the shops, and in that area can also purchase an approved independent tour provided by the local government. Please note that these tours are unaffiliated with Celebrity.  Vaccinated guests can explore the destination on their own in: Basseterre, St. Kitts & Nevis; Belize City, Belize; Bimini, Bahamas; Cartagena, Colombia; Colon, Panama; Costa Maya, Mexico; Cozumel, Mexico; Falmouth, Jamaica; George Town, Grand Cayman; Key West, USA; Kralendijk, Bonaire; Nassau, Bahamas; Oranjestad, Aruba; Philipsburg, St. Maarten*; Puerto Limon, Costa Rica; Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic; Puerto Quetzal, Guatemala; Roatan, Honduras; San Juan, Puerto Rico; St. Croix, USVI; St. George's, Grenada; St. John's, Antigua; St. Thomas, USVI; Tortola, BVI; Willemstad, Curacao.  *The St. Maarten government requires all unvaccinated guests age 10 and older, be tested 2 days prior to disembarking and visiting St. Maarten. Test will be provided onboard.  The local health authorities in St. Thomas and St. Croix require that all guests, including vaccinated persons wear a mask in all seaports and airports and on All transportation.  While in Anuba and Grenada, the use of masks is required while indoors, except for while eating and drinking.
 Travel Home Testing	Home country test provided based on requirements (offered on mainland Ecuador). Complimentary Antigen or PCR test for package guests. For Non-Package guests, testing facilities can be recommended and we can assist with coordination.	All fully vaccinated guests requiring a COVID-19 test to return to their home country will be provided the opportunity to receive testing in the cruise port during disembarkation. Proof of return travel scheduled within 24 hours of disembarkation will be required. Details on testing registration will be provided onboard. Testing will be complimentary for guests with cruise reservations booked prior to November 16, 2021. For new bookings made on or after November 16, 2021, testing will be available for a per person fee. The cost for onsite cruise port testing starts at \$99* per person. Prices vary by port and test type.  *Test prices are set by each vendor and not by Celebrity Cruises. Payments will be made directly to the vendor providing the service.
