Please do not make early travel plans on the day of debarkation to allow time for the required testing process. -The per person cost for these tests is \$178 and will be applied to your onboard folio. -Masks will be required at all times onboard except while eating or drinking. -Unvaccinated guests are required to book a Celebrity curated tour, and depending on local government requirements, unvaccinated guests may be further restricted from going ashore. -Unvaccinated guests will have designated seating areas* in all venues such as the dining rooms, casino, theatre, etc. -Unvaccinated guests will not have access to gym or spa*. *Venue access is validated via Sea Pass card.
