Each country on your sailing will have unique immigration requirements. Please be sure to contact the embassy or consular visa services of your choice for specific visa requirements, information, forms, and fees as these differ by nationality. It is the responsibility of each guest to identify and obtain all required travel documents for the entire cruise vacation. Please note that guests who do not provide the proper documentation at check-in may be denied boarding.

To ensure the smoothest possible check-in and boarding experience in Yokohama, please follow the below requirements:

Please bring 2 photocopies of your passport information/photo page.

## Japan

- For UK, US, and Canadian passport holders, a visa is not required for Korea. Requirements for entry visas differ by nationality, therefore please check if your specific nationality will require a visa.

## Korea

• For UK, US, and Canadian passport holders, a visa is not required for Korea. Requirements for entry visas differ by nationality, therefore please check if your specific nationality will require a visa.

## China

- Regulations for transiting through a country by air will differ for when you are traveling by sea.

  Unless your passport is visa-exempt for China, you need to obtain at least a single-entry Chinese visa.
- This visa will allow the greatest level of flexibility when booking your departure flights from Shanghai and it can also be used should you wish to change plans in any of the Chinese ports.
- Please note:
  - The Chinese Embassy has introduced fingerprint collection for visa applicants. Ensure that you
    allow adequate time to obtain your Chinese visa as you may need to make an additional
    appointment to submit your fingerprints.
  - All guests must present a printed copy of their valid travel itinerary. Itineraries must be current and clearly document the names of all guests.

For your convenience, we will collect all guest passports after check-in, in order to complete the immigration formalities for you at each port of call. Your passport will be held in a safe location at Guest Relations on board and will be returned to you when all procedures are complete.
