Dear Guest,

We have some urgent information to provide regarding your upcoming 14-Night China & South Korea sailing, originally scheduled to depart from Hong Kong, on March 14th, 2020 aboard Celebrity Millennium®

As you may be aware, China is currently experiencing an outbreak of coronavirus. Due to the rapid spread of this virus the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared the outbreak a Public Health Emergency of International Concern. A Public Health Emergency will allow all governments to proactively dedicate resources and attention to preventing the spread of coronavirus and ensuring the safety of all citizens and travelers around the world. Rest assured, the health and safety of our guests and crew is Celebrity Cruises' number one priority.

To that end, the decision has been made to adjust our itinerary for the Millennium voyage of March 14th by replacing Hong Kong as the port of embarkation with Tokyo, Japan, as well as, replacing Shanghai, China as the port of debarkation with Singapore on March 28th. These changes will also require cancellation of our double overnight visit to Beijing, China on March 22nd through the 24th and our call to Seoul, Korea on March 26th. Alternatively, we will now visit Mt. Fuji and Kagoshima, Japan on March 15th and 17th and Taiwan, China on March 22nd as well as Hue/Danang, Vietnam on March 25th.

If you no longer wish to sail onboard the Millennium for the modified March 14th voyage you may cancel your booking and receive a 100% Future Cruise Credit to sail on another date. You also have the option of keeping your booking on the new itinerary and receiving up to \$500 person reimbursement for any airline flight change fees incurred. In order to receive reimbursement, you must send us a copy of the air change fees assessed. Please email to, celebrityengagementcenter@celebrity.com

If you pre-booked any shore excursions through Celebrity Cruises for Hong Kong, Beijing, Seoul or Shanghai, you'll receive a full refund to the original form of payment. Additional excursion opportunities for Mt. Fuji, Kagoshima, Hue/Danang and Singapore will be available for booking online pre-cruise and onboard. Guests with independent arrangements should contact their tour operators as soon as possible.

Additionally, visas will be issued upon arrival in Vietnam for most nationalities. However, requirements for entry visas differ by nationality, therefore, please check if your specific nationality will require a visa. Guests from the following countries will be required to apply for a visa **before** boarding: Pakistan, North Korea, Afghanistan, Iraq, Nigeria, Israel, Sri Lanka, Turkey, Iran, Morocco, Yemen Arab Republic, Saudi Arabia, Oman, Bangladesh, Jordan, Cameroon, Democratic Republic of The Congo, Sierra Leone, South Africa, Mozambique, Kenya, Ghana.

After further consultation with public health authorities and medical experts, we have decided that any guest, or crewmember, who has traveled to, from, or through China or Hong Kong within 15 days of departure will be unable to board our ships – this includes guests who had connecting flights in China or Hong Kong. As a result, it is imperative that you check your air travel itinerary closely to ensure you do not transit through any gateway in China or Hong Kong. Guests who have air travel booked through Flights by Celebrity will be re-accommodated on alternate routes and receive new flight information automatically. Guests with independent air travel arrangements need to contact their air carriers directly to make all required adjustments and changes to their air travel.

Guest holding Chinese passports but residing outside of China, or any guest who has been in contact with persons who have visited China or Hong Kong, will receive a secondary health screening.
